

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FORM DB-36-A
(SPECIAL REINSTATEMENT QUESTIONNAIRE)**

1. This Form is intended for use by attorneys petitioning for reinstatement from inactive status, retired status or administrative suspension for more than three years. Disbarred, Suspended, or attorneys inactive due to Disability **must** use Form DB-36 (Reinstatement Questionnaire).
2. You must attach a Certificate of Good Standing (or certification of current status, if not active) and a letter of ethical conduct (disciplinary history) for every jurisdiction where you are currently admitted to practice outside of PA. See Question 4.
3. You must attach a letter from the Pennsylvania Lawyers Fund for Client Security indicating that no restitution is owed to the Fund. You may request this letter by either calling 1-800-962-4618 or faxing your request to (717) 231-9511. See Question 7.
4. You must attach at least three (3) letters of reference relating to your moral qualifications, competency and/or learning in the law. See Question 11.
5. If you have any unsatisfied judgments against you, you are required to attach a copy of each judgment. See Question 13.
6. You must attach proof of attendance for **all** courses listed in response to Question 15(d). You may obtain a copy of your PA Attorney Credit's Report by calling the PA Continuing Legal Education Board at 1-800-497-2253 or downloading a copy from their Website at www.pacle.org.
7. Attorneys seeking reinstatement must complete 36 hours of accredited PA CLE courses, 12 of which must be in the area of Ethics, within one year preceding the filing of the petition for reinstatement. You must complete all courses prior to filing the petition and attach proof of attendance at all of the courses listed in response to Question 15(d).
8. If you have taken courses in another jurisdiction, those course credits may be eligible for credit in PA. You may want to contact the PA CLE Board to learn what steps must be taken to have those courses added to your record or visit their Website at www.pacle.org.
9. If you are required to take mandatory continuing legal education in any other jurisdiction, you must attach proof of compliance with that jurisdiction's CLE requirements. See Question 15(f).
10. You are required to file four (4) notarized original Waiver of Confidentiality forms, four (4) signed copies of the Special Reinstatement Questionnaire and attachments thereto, and one (1) original Petition for reinstatement. There is no filing fee for reinstatement.
11. After the Petition for reinstatement is filed, it will be referred to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, and that Office has 60 days to file a response and will serve a copy on you. If Disciplinary Counsel files a certification stating that after a review of your petition, they have determined that there is no impediment to reinstatement and that you will meet your burden of proof under the Rules, there is no need for a hearing. The matter will be referred to a Board Member for review and recommendation. If the Board Member approves the petition, it will be forwarded to the Supreme Court with a proposed order granting the reinstatement. It will also be recommended that you be ordered to reimburse the Board for the costs incurred in processing the matter. These costs average between \$10 and \$20.
12. If Disciplinary Counsel files a response objecting to the reinstatement, the Office of the Secretary shall refer the Petition and Response to a Hearing Committee Member and schedule the matter for hearing. In this situation, the costs will be higher due to the additional costs associated with a hearing. The procedure will also take longer, since the matter will be referred to the full Board for review after the Hearing Committee Member files his or her report.
